There are two scholarships available, each is for \$1000.00, and will be awarded to the most deserving applicants as determined by the Kiwanis Club of Fairbanks, Scholarship Committee. This scholarship is awarded without regard to gender, race, ethnic origin, or disabilities.

Applicants must be a 2011 graduating senior of an accredited high school in the Fairbanks North Star Borough. Applicants must be a United States citizen or legally authorized alien.

Applications will be ranked based on 100 points maximum as follows:

Perseverance and Resourcefulness	20

The scholarships will be awarded directly to the recipients upon proof of enrollment in an accredited college, university, or trade school. The scholarship may be withdrawn if not used by the student within two (2) academic years of the award.
